### Windows Driver

## Checking the software/firmware versions

## Procedures for updating the computer software

### Preparing

- If the latest software has already been installed, there is no need to update it. Use it as is.
- Disconnect all cables connected to the unit.
- Set the phantom power switch to off.

### Updating the Windows driver

1. Download the latest driver for the operating system you are using from the TEAC Global Site (<http://teac-global.com/>) and save it on the computer to be used with the unit.
2. Open the saved driver (zip file) on, for example, the computer desktop.
3. After uncompression, double-click the "TASCAM\_US-16x08\_X.XX.exe" ("X.XX" is the number of version) file in the folder that appears after uncompression to automatically launch the installation software.
4. After this, follow the installation procedures in "Installing the dedicated driver for Windows" in the Owner's Manual.
