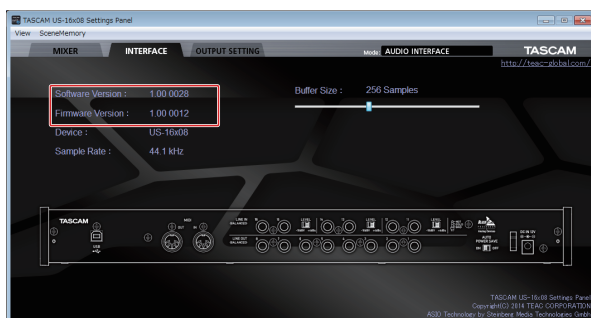
#### ■ Version 1.01

## Checking the software/firmware versions

Before beginning to update the software/firmware, check the software/firmware version of the US-16x08 unit being used.

## Procedures for updating the computer software

### Preparing

- If the latest software has already been installed, there is no need to update it. Use it as is.
- Disconnect all cables connected to the unit.
- Set the phantom power switch to off.

### Updating the Windows driver

- Download the latest driver for the operating system you are using from the TEAC Global Site (<http://teac-global.com/>) and save it on the computer to be used with the unit.
- Open the saved driver (zip file) on, for example, the computer desktop.
- After uncompression, double-click the "TASCAM\_US-16x08\_X.XX.exe" ("X.XX" is the number of version) file in the folder that appears after uncompression to automatically launch the installation software.
- After this, follow the installation procedures in "Installing the dedicated driver for Windows" in the Owner's Manual.
